Re: Nominations for President and Executive Vice President

This is the second call for nominations for the President and Executive Vice President that will be elected at the 2009 AGM & Conference to be held at the Memorial Sports Centre, Town of Fort Frances from April 15 – 18, 2009.

The two persons elected to these positions will hold office for a two year term commencing from April 18, 2009 and terminate when their predecessors are elected at the 2011 AGM.

A person may be nominated by any member of Council by forwarding the nomination to me by mail or by fax.

Following are the nominations and elections procedures that were approved by the Board of Directors.

1. There will be three (3) calls for nominations for both of these offices. The first call was made on January 14, 2009, and this is the second call. A further call will be made on or before March 15th. In addition to this there will be three (3) calls for further nominations at the AGM on Friday, April 17th immediately following the morning refreshment break. Persons may be nominated by any official delegate but only elected representatives (heads of council and members of council) may be nominated for these positions.
2. If only one nomination is received, the nominee, if he or she accepts will be acclaimed to the position. If more than one nomination is received for either position, the nominees will be asked if they wish to stand for the position. This will be done in reverse order of receiving the nomination.
3. If more than one person consents to their nomination, two scrutineers will be appointed to conduct the election.
4. Persons nominated will be provided the opportunity of addressing the delegates at the AGM on Friday, April 17th immediately following the afternoon break. Each candidate will be allowed a maximum of three (3) minutes to address the delegates.
5. The vote shall be by written ballot and only official delegates will receive a ballot/s. In accordance with Section 8 of the Constitution, each member municipality will have a

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maximum of six (6) votes and if there are more than six (6) official delegates attending the AGM the municipality shall advise the Executive Director in advance of the AGM, the delegates that have been selected to vote for their municipality.

6. Elections will be conducted on Saturday, April 18th commencing at 9:00 a.m. and the polls will close at 10:00 a.m.
7. A list of eligible voters shall be provided by the Executive Director.
8. The results of the vote/s shall be final and the successful candidate/s will be announced by the President immediately after the ballots have been counted.
9. A motion to destroy the ballots shall be requested.
10. The President and the Executive Vice President elect will have the opportunity to address the delegates.

Member municipalities will be advised of the nominations received through the advance call for nominations as they are received.

We look forward to receiving nominations from your community.
